

# North Carolina State Board of Registration for Foresters Continuing Forestry Education Personal Activity Record

Rule **.0123 CONTINUING EDUCATION** reads as follows:

- (a.) All registered foresters shall attend continuing education courses annually to maintain their registration. **Ten CFE** (Continuing Forester Education) credits approved by the Society of American Foresters' CFE Coordinator shall be required each year, except as outlined in paragraph (c.). CFEs must be SAF category 1, 2, 3 or 4, with at least six being from category 1\*.
- (b.) Registered foresters shall verify CFE compliance to the Board with each annual renewal.
- (c.) Those registered foresters who provide information to the Board which verifies that they are fully retired from a career in forestry may qualify to continue their registration by earning a minimum of three category 1, 2, 3, or 4 CFEs annually.

\*Category 1 designation includes attending educational forestry related workshops. Category 2 covers educational non-forestry workshops that may be supportive of the forestry field (such as computer training courses). Category 3 involves organizing and/or conducting related workshops. Category 4 includes authoring, reviewing, and editing forestry publications.

**This form must be filed with your fiscal year 2009-2010 annual renewal, due June 30, 2009. A copy of the CFE Contact Hours Notice (Category 1 credits ONLY) MUST be submitted with this form.**
